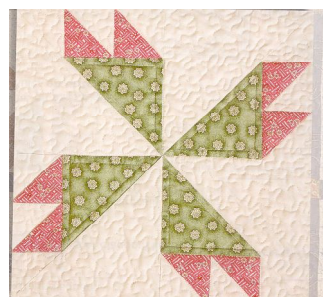


Block of the Month May

Rosebud



Color 1-Background-off white

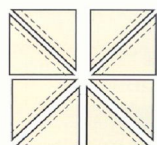
(1) 6" square- (2) 3" squares- (2) 7" squares

Color 2 –rosebud- any flower color you want

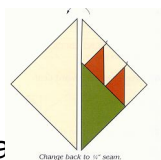
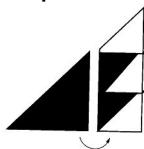
(1) 6" square

Color 3 – leaf, green (2) 5" squares

1. Place 6" sq. background and rosebud fabric right sides together.
2. Draw 2 diagonal lines on wrong side of background square.
3. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ inch from both sides of diagonal lines.
4. Cut on drawn lines, then cut horizontally and vertically. You will have 8 pieces.
5. Press to rosebud fabric and trim to $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch sq



6. Cut 2 3" background squares in half diagonally. Sew half sq to 2 rosebuds sewn together. You will do this 4 times.
7. Cut 2 five inch leaf squares in half diagonally. Sew the short side of the triangle to the rosebuds



8. Cut two 7" background squares in half diagonally. Sew the long side of the triangle to the long side of rosebud unit
9. Square up each set of Rosebuds to measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".
10. Lay out your blocks as shown in the diagram. Sew vertically rows and then through the middle.
