

Christmas Basket
Block of the month

Colors – red and green scraps- color 1
Background - Muslin- Color 2

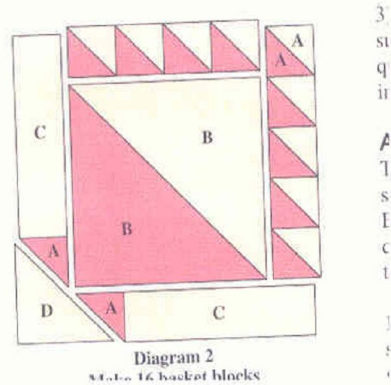
Nine $\frac{1}{2}$ sq triangle squares measuring $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches- using your muslin and scraps of red and green.

Two $8\frac{7}{8}$ squares- one from background and one from red or green scrap.
You will sew them together $\frac{1}{4}$ inch from center line on either side
You will have a finished sq $8\frac{1}{2}$ inch.

From Background you will cut two $2\frac{1}{2} \times 8\frac{1}{2}$ rectangles, fig C – you will cut one $2\frac{7}{8}$ square the same color as you basket into 2 -attach to your rectangles. Fig C and A.

From Background you will cut one $4\frac{7}{8}$ sq in half for the base of your basket. Fig D

To assemble- Four of the $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch triangles will be sewn together and the five $2\frac{1}{2}$ sq triangles will be sewn together with the muslin on the right.



Then attach letter C to the sides and lastly attach letter D.
