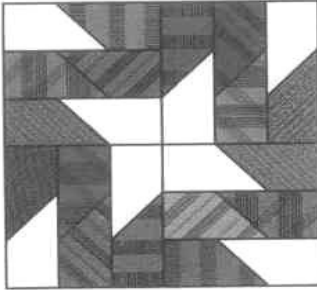


Block of the Month

SCRAPPY STAR (blue or red)

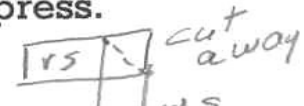
Due in April – 12 ½ inch square

Units – light fabric – 2 ½ by 4 ½ length - 8 units

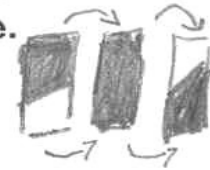
Dark fabric- 4 ½ by 6 ½ straight piece of blue or red – 4 units

Dark fabric – 8 units 2 ½ by 4 ½ - blue or red

1. Sew a light unit to a dark unit(2 ½ by 4 ½). Right sides together as if you were sewing two binding strips together. Sew on the diagonal from left to right. Cut the triangle and press.



2. Sew a dark unit to a light unit the same as above. Lay the light side on the left bottom, the straight piece in the middle and the dark side down with the light at the top on the right side.



3. Sew all three pieces together. Should measure 6 ½ inches.

4. You will make four units and sew them together with the first star point aiming up to the right, second piece goes to the left with light side making a star. Continue as shown in the star on the left top. Join two pieces together at the top and the bottom and then join them through the middle.

5. The next persons star will fit next to yours.
