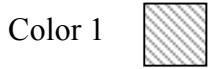


## Block of the Month

This block will be **demonstrated** at the **April** Meeting.

### Antique Tiles Block

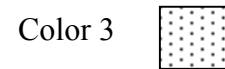
You will need three fabrics, a floral and two complimentary solids or small prints.



(darker complimentary )

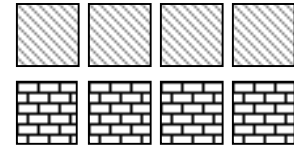


(floral)

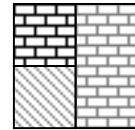


(lighter complimentary)

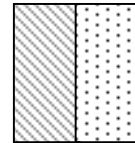
Cut four 2 ½ inch squares each from Colors 1 and 2 for a total of 8 squares. Sew each Color 1 square to a Color 2 square for a total of 4 pairs. Press the seam to the darker fabric. Lay each pair with the Color 2 square at the top.



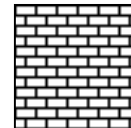
Cut four 2 ½ by 4 ½ inch rectangles of Color 2. Place a Color 2 rectangle face down on top of each pair. Stitch down the right side of the sandwich. Press the seam toward the rectangle. Make **four** of these corner units.



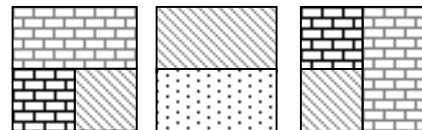
Cut four 2 ½ by 4 ½ inch rectangles from each of colors 1, 2 and 3 for a total of 12 rectangles. Make **four** pairs of Color 1 and Color 3 rectangles, right sides together. Stitch and press toward the darker fabric.



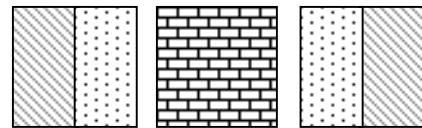
Cut a 4 ½ inch square from Color 2. This is the center of your block.



Arrange the pairs of rectangles to the North, South, East and West of the center, with the Color 3 rectangle next to the center.



Place the corner units in the four corners with the Color 1 square diagonal to the center square. You now have a large 9- patch.



Sew the mini-blocks in each row together, then sew the rows together to complete the block
