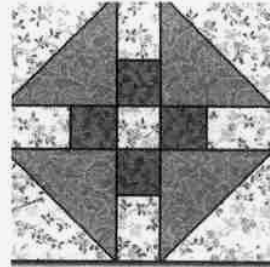


Block of the Month

Color one- floral print

Color two- medium coordinating fabric

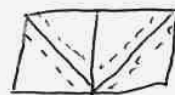
Color three – dark fabric

Prepare the pieces- Color 1 – cut four $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips or cut one piece $2\frac{1}{2}$ by 14 inch strip. Cut one piece $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Then cut one piece 6 " by 12 " piece.

Color two – one 6" by 12" piece.

Color three - four $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square or one strip $2\frac{1}{2}$ by 10 inches.

Step one – sew piece the half square triangles by stacking color 1 and color two with the right sides facing. On the light color draw a line straight down the middle and on the diagonal. Sew scant $\frac{1}{4}$ inch line above and below the line. Cut down the center and in between the sewn lines. Trim to $5\frac{1}{2}$ inch square.

Step two – Sew color three ($2\frac{1}{2}$ square) to each of the color 1 strips ($2\frac{1}{2}$ by $3\frac{1}{2}$)

Step three- Sew one of the rectangle strips to the right side of the half square triangle. Add another half square triangle unit to the strip. Sew seam allowances towards the center strip. Make two of these units.

Step four – Sew color one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square to the remaining two rectangle units.

Final step- Sew top piece to the strip in the middle and then sew the last set of triangles to the bottom. And presto, you have a LOVERS KNOT.
