I finished the heart quilt for my golfing buddy and now have some repairs to make. It seems my idea of not using fusible product behind the appliquéd hearts was not such a great idea. My intention was to hand quilt the hearts and I didn't want even more layers to go through; hand quilting is hard enough when the fingers don't always want to cooperate. I completed the entire quilt, and then washed it to get the chalk marks out. Even though I had washed the fabric before I cut it (Cardinal rule in my house), it must have shrunk because the fabric has slipped out of the zig zag (ah, my spell check just fainted) stitches, and now I have to figure out how to do this repair. It's so frustrating.

I am still looking for two more volunteers for the 2010 Nominating Committee, so if you have some time and would like to help out, please let me know. We will also be looking for someone to take over the Newsletter, Membership, Librarian, and Historian positions for next year. She will discuss and show many of her quilts that had a mistake and how she overcame the problem. You are encouraged to bring a quilt in which there is a mistake, and Linda will discuss the solutions! Don't be modest or embarrassed! All quilts will be welcomed!!

Linda's 6 hour workshop will begin after the meeting on Tuesday and continue Wednesday morning. The title of the workshop is "Fantasy Flowers". You may choose to make a block or a wall-hanging.
