### Recipe of the Month

#### **Applesauce Chocolate Cake**

This is a recipe from my mother's 1930's recipe book. I used to sneak a slice from the cupboard every chance I'd get.

2 C. flour	1 tsp. cinnamon
"Pinch" of salt	1/2 tsp. cloves
1 C. sugar	1/2 tsp. nutmeg
1 tsp. baking soda	1 T. cornstarch
1 tsp. baking powder	3 T. cocoa
	1 C. raisins

Sift the above together---add raisins.

Add: 1/2 C. melted butter, 1 egg, 1 1/2 C. unsweetened applesauce. Mix till well blended. Bake at 350 until toothpick comes out clean. \*Best with chocolate fudge icing.
