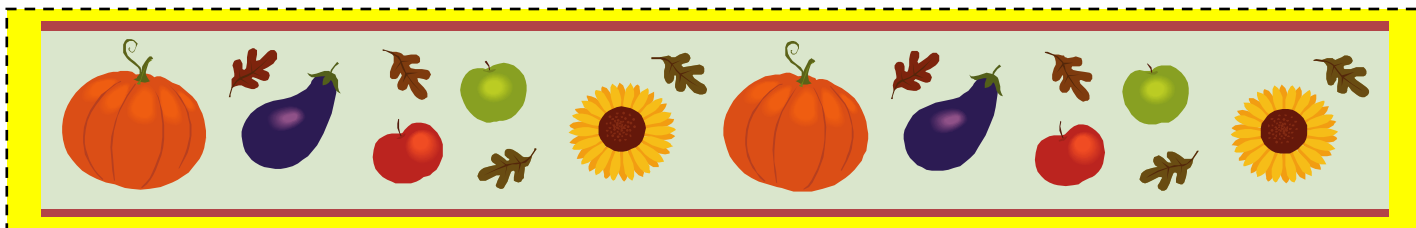

Recipe of the Month

Apple Noodle Pudding

½ pound flat egg noodles, cooked
 4 large eggs or 1 cup egg substitute
 8 ounces creamed cottage cheese
 ½ cup butter or margarine, melted
 ½ cup sugar
 1 cup milk
 3 apples, peeled and sliced
 1-2 teaspoons cinnamon sugar

Combine first 6 ingredients, tossing gently. Spoon into a greased 2-quart baking dish. Place apple slices on top and sprinkle with cinnamon sugar.

Bake at 375 for 1 hour.

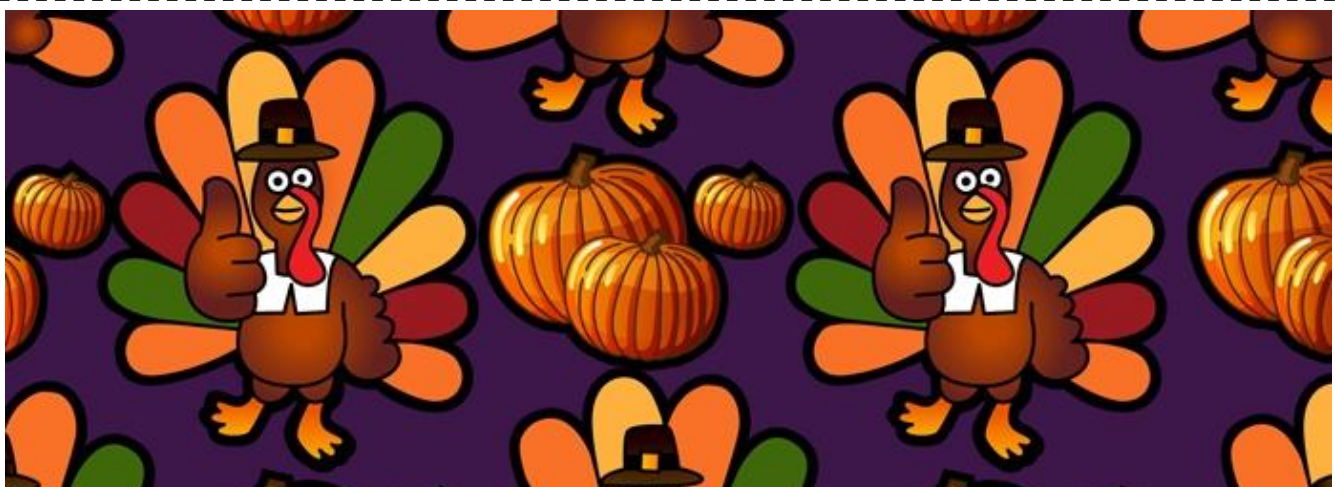
Angel Block Challenge
